Ladybird Grove and Mess Hall Conditions:

Fourth Ward Neighbors Statement of Support for Live Music at Ladybird

During the November 16, 2021 General Body Meeting of Fourth Ward Neighbors (“FWN”), the Neighborhood voted 13-1 in support of live music at Ladybird located on John Wesley Dobbs Avenue.

This strong statement of support is recognition of Ladybird’s history of being an excellent neighbor and a tremendous asset to the neighborhood.

To maintain a great neighborhood for both businesses and residents, this support is conditioned on the following:

- Any live music will end by 9 p.m.
- All music will occur on the Grove (i.e., Beltline) side of the Ladybird property
- Ladybird will investigate sound mitigation management – trees, etc.
- Only live music and no DJs
- Ladybird will notify neighbors through FWN of any permitted live music activities outside these conditions
- Ladybird will share what they are doing with Inman Park
